SUBJECT: MATHEMATICAL PROBLEM SOLVING MATERIALS NEEDED: PENCIL & PAPER

PROMPTS:

- 1.Your class has recently gone to Island H2O for a field trip. Your class has 28 students, some wearing swim trunks, some wearing swim suits. There were 3 times as many students wearing swim trunks than swimsuits. How many students wore swim trunks?
- 2. There are 36 students standing in line at Profile Plunge waiting to ride. There are 5 rafts in the rotation and each raft can hold 6 people. How many rafts will it take before all 36 people can say they have rode the ride?
- 3. Chat Creek lazy river can accommodate 3 students at a time on inflatable rafts. Each ride lasts for exactly 10 minutes. If the students want to make sure everyone gets a turn and starts riding simultaneously, how many rounds of lazy river rides will they need to complete?

PROMPTS:

- Susan counted 200 clear tubes throughout the park at Island H2O. Charlotte counted 170 yellow tubes in the same park. How many tubes did they count together?
- Sam bought some socks at Island Outfitters retail store. His friend Matt gave him 62 more. Sam now has 127. How many socks did Sam originally have?
- Megabytes had 120 chocolate chip cookies to sell. They sold some of those cookies and now only have 80 left. How many cookies did Terrace Treats sell?
- Live Lagoon Wave Pool can hold 900 people. There are currently 367 boys in the pool. How many girls are in the wave pool if it's at max capacity?
- Apps & Eats needs to sell 345 pretzels. They are currently running a buy 2 get 1 free special. How many customers will it take to sell out of pretzels?
